For locals wanting to obtain a SAS Coastal Skipper Certificate:

WHY DO YOU NEED A SOUTH AFRICAN SKIPPERS TICKET?

- You need a South African (SAS) qualification to sail a yacht over 9m at sea in South Africa
- Neither the Royal Yachting Association (RYA) nor any other qualification is accepted by the South African authorities. There is, however a special arrangement for visiting yachts.

SAS Office in Cape Town is 021 531 1860/8022.

An additional fee of R800.00 will be payable to Atlantic Yachting. **Please notify office should you want to apply for your SAS Day Skippers Ticket/SAS Coastal Ticket ~ before you come on course.**

NOTE: In order to apply for your SAS Coastal Skippers Certificate you will need:

- SAMSA SRC Radio License 2019 external exam fee R1 150.00
- SAS ISHARA Eye Test
- SAS Exam Fee: SAS non-member R2 490.00 / SAS member R1 660.00
- You must have all the pre requisites required to qualify
